SUPERINTENDENT

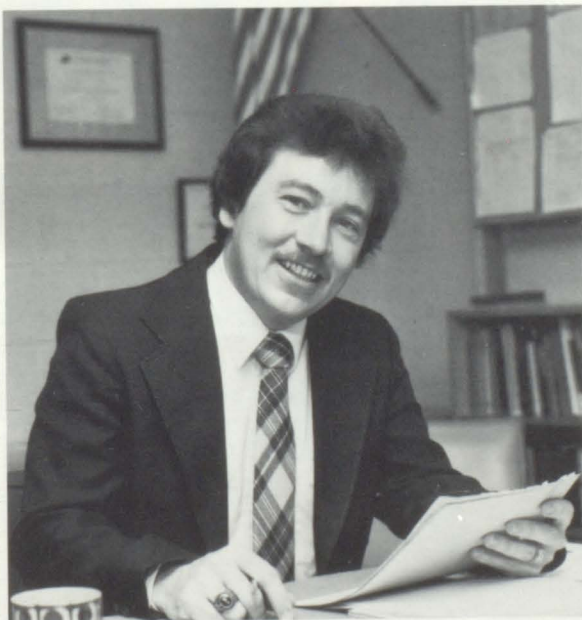
